- Provost Harper will investigate covering the staff and faculty payroll to cover Early Start, he will have an answer by mid-February.
- Jackson asks the committee to collaborate with their teams and think about what summer 2021 could look like thinking about serving the Fall 2021 students for Early Start and Fall 2020 in terms of reaching the Finish Line. We should have an answer from Provost Harper about how much money he can supply and at the next meeting, we can begin to plan it.

<u>CSU EO 1110 Intercampus Coaching Program for 2021</u> – The committee agrees to thanks but no thanks for receiving or serving as a coach.

<u>A2 and B4 completion at end of Fall 2020</u>-Jackson would like to investigate further as the numbers do not match up, she will ask M. Malhotra to run the data for Fall 2019 as she did for Fall 2020 to verify the data we have.

<u>Placement A2 B4 Grades</u>- The committee discusses the Placement A2 B4 spreadsheet that was emailed to the group. We will look at the data again at the end of Spring 2021 when students have had a chance to completed Stretch and see what our numbers are like at that time.

- We need to keep in mind that this year we will not be receiving SATs, ACTs, and Smarter Balance, this will deeply affect our numbers in placement.
- We need to think about if we want to offer a substitute for the tests they should have had. For Math we have ALEKS in place, do we want to offer ALEKS placement tests on a larger scale to students?
- English, is there something that we can offer to students to get properly recognized? We need to consider either a testing option or using Early Start as a place adjuster.
- R. Perez mentioned that a lot of campuses will be offering courses that will allow students to move up, it is up to the schools if it's something they want to offer.

<u>Summer Early Start 2021</u>- We need to think about what we want Summer 2021 to look like in terms of Early Start.

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- Jackson states we have 1.6 million dollars to take care of Early Start Fall 2020 and Fall 2021. This money is strictly financial assistance to the students, it must go directly to the students. Provost Harper will look into covering the staff and faculty payroll to cover Early Start, he will have an answer by mid-February.
- Jackson asks the committee to work with their teams and think about what summer 2021 could look like thinking about serving the Fall 2021 students for Early Start and Fall 2020 in terms of reaching the Finish Line. We should have an answer from Provost Harper about how much money he can provide and at the next meeting we can begin to plan it.
- If we are making any changes to existing courses, where it be the number of units or content, we will need to run that through the Curriculum Committee.
- If we get the green light from the CO to do the residential program, we would merge with EOP, though Jackson still needs to talk with Steve Walsh.

ForeRunners Peer Mentoring – Jackson and Whitaker have been meeting weekly to make plans regarding the ForeRunners for Spring 2021. Whitaker is working on recruiting peer mentors; he has recruited ten mentors so far but needs a few more in the pre-calc and stem courses. We need to remember they are not tutors more like someone to help keep a personal connection to the student who may be struggling through virtual learning.

<u>KINE 2018 Updates</u> – K. Grappendorf states for KINE 2018 they will provide tutoring and supplemental instruction assuming they find people, they are working on identifying those now to serve as tutors or TA's for the instructors. She is meeting with Kyle and Janet later this week about some of the logistic issues. We are offering KINE 2018 but are not requiring it, we are working on guided registration.
