



## Subject Matter Worksheet – Single Subject

### Option 1 – Degree major verification

Is your bachelor's degree, master's degree, or doctorate major aligned to the single subject content area you are seeking? Check the aligned majors list to see: [Aligned Majors](#).

### Option 2 – Subject Matter Program

Did you attend a subject matter approved program as an undergraduate (bachelor's program)? Not sure if you did or didn't attend an approved program? Check on the approved program list: [Subject Matter Approved Programs](#)

☐ If yes, request a subject matter waiver letter from the institution you received your bachelor's degree from. Include this letter in your program application to show you met subject matter.

☐ If no, try a different option for subject matter.

### Option 3 – Full coursework verification

Review the domains of Single Subject content matter you are seeking to see if you have previously taken coursework in each of the domain areas. [Subject Matter Domains](#).

### Option 4 – Exams
