Additional Graduation Requirements that must be met:

- A minimum of 120 semester units is required, a maximum of 70 Community College units can be applied to the 120 units required for graduation.
- A minimum of 40 upper division units is required. Upper division units at CSUB are courses that start with a 3000+ or 4000+ course number.
- Residency Requirement: Students must complete a minimum of 30 semester units in residency study at CSUB. At least 24 of those 30 units shall be earned in upper division courses, and at least 12 of those upper division units shall be in the major.
- At graduation time, students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA at CSUB, a minimum 2.0 GPA Overall, a minimum 2.0 GPA in your major (pre-requisite courses do not count towards this GPA), and a minimum 2.0 GPA in your minor (if you have one).
