## Bakersfield National Pan-Hellenic Council (NPHC)

The NPHC was founded in 1930 at Howard University. According to the NPHC, each of the nine organizations (“Divine Nine”) evolved during a period when African Americans were being denied essential rights and privileges afforded to others. Racial isolation on predominantly white campuses and social barriers of class on all campuses created a need for African Americans to align themselves with other individuals sharing common goals and ideals.
