



Clinical Requirements Reference Sheet

Please use this list as a reference to complete the clinical requirements. Every student will be required to upload each requirement as an attachment into Verified Credentials and/or MyClinicalExchange.

PLEASE NOTE: All clinical requirements MUST be valid through the end of the academic year (5/14/2027)-No exceptions! Instructions to sign up for MyClinicalExchange will be provided at the July orientation, but students need to start on the immunizations ASAP to avoid any delays in completion.

1. Physical Examination
 - i. Physical Exam must be completed after May 14, 2026, and signed by a medical professional.
 - ii. Must use the CSUB Nursing form provided
2. Measles, Mumps, & Rubella (MMR)
 - i. Submit proof of vaccination series (2 doses) OR a positive antibody titer (lab report required).
 - ii. If titer is non-reactive/negative, need to receive a booster
3. Varicella (Chicken Pox)
 - i. Submit proof of vaccination series OR a positive antibody titer (lab report required).
 - ii. If titer is non-reactive/negative, need to receive a booster
4. Hepatitis B
 - i. Submit proof of vaccination series OR a positive antibody titer (lab report required).
 - ii. If titer is non-reactive/negative, need to receive a booster
5. Tuberculosis (TB)
 - i. Submit **one** of the following which has been completed after May 14, 2026:
 - i. Negative TB blood test (lab report required). Recommended if ever had the BCG vaccination.
 - ii. TB skin test, must have two negative tests within 4 weeks of each other if this option is chosen.
If positive results:
 - a. proof of past positive testing AND
 - b. a clear chest x-ray (lab report required) from the last 2 years.
6. Tetanus, Diphtheria, & Pertussis (TDaP)
 - i. Submit documentation of a Tetanus, Diphtheria & Pertussis (TDaP) vaccination, administered within the past 10 years.



7. Influenza (Flu)

- i. Submit documentation of a Flu vaccination, can be submitted at a later time
- ii. **Complete during flu season only - Due by October 1st**

8. Basic Life Support-CPR Certification

- i. Submit proof of a valid American Heart Association (AHA) or American Red Cross Basic Life Support Certification/Card
 - i. Online courses are acceptable as long as they include an in person skills session.
- ii. See Nursing website for certification options

9. Mask Fit Testing

- i. Mask fit testing will be completed in the first two weeks of classes. There is no need to complete it at this time.
