

CSU Bakersfield Campus Emergency Procedures

Active Shooter

RUN, HIDE, FIGHT

RUN

- If there is an escape path, use your best judgement, attempt to evacuate
- Leave your belongings behind
- Help others escape the area and prevent from entering, if possible
- Call 9-1-1 or (661) 654-2111 when you are safe

HIDE AND LOCKDOWN

- If evacuation is not possible, find a place to hide
- Lock and/or barricade door
- Silence your cell phone
- Spread out, do not group together
- Remain quiet
- Hide behind large objects

FIGHT

- As a last resort, and only if your life is in danger
- Attempt to incapacitate the shooter
- Act with physical aggression
- Throw items and yell at shooter to distract
- Improvise weapons, throw pencils, books, water bottles, etc.
- Commit to your actions

General Evacuation Information

- In the event of a building alarm or a campus wide notification, evacuate the building at the nearest exit (or alternate if near exit is blocked).
- Do not use elevators!
- Take personal belongings (keys, wallets, etc).
- Secure any hazardous materials or equipment before leaving
- Follow directions given by emergency personnel and/or CSU Bakersfield Police Officers.
- Respond to designated collection points or to an area otherwise instructed by Emergency Personnel and/or CSU Bakersfield Police.
- If it is safe for you to assist a person with a disability or special needs, do so. If you are unable to assist, notify emergency responders of the location and number of disabled or special needs individuals located in your area.
- Wait to be contacted. Do not return to the building or move to another side of the building unless told to do so by Emergency Personnel.

Bomb Threat

- Evacuate the building
- Do not use cell phones or radios without 300 feet of the area suspected of containing explosive device.
- Faculty/Staff should check for, but not disturb, unusual objects as they depart the classroom or offices. Report these unusual objects to the CSU Bakersfield Police and Emergency Personnel.
- Do not enter a building until authorized by Emergency Personnel/CSU Bakersfield Police.

Fire

- Activate the nearest fire alarm pull station and call 9-1-1 from a campus phone to access the CSU Bakersfield Police or dial (661) 654-2111 from all other phones.
- Evacuate the building
- Do not re-enter the building until authorized by Emergency Personnel.

Earthquakes/Severe Weather

- Stay away from windows.
- Drop to your hands and knees, seek cover under a sturdy piece of furniture, and hold on to that piece of furniture.
- Call 9-1-1 from a Campus phone or dial (661) 654-2111 to access CSU Bakersfield Police if medical assistance is needed.

Power Outage

- Move cautiously to a lighted area. Exits may be indicated by lighted signs.
- Turn off and unplug computers and other voltage sensitive equipment.

Suspicious Person

- Do not physically confront the person.
- Do not let anyone into a locked building or office
- If the individual is inside, do not block the person's access to an exit.
- Call 9-1-1 from a Campus phone or dial (661) 654-2111 to access CSU Bakersfield Police. Provide as much information as possible about the person and their direction of travel.

Suspicious Object

- Do not touch or disturb the object.
- Call 9-1-1 from a campus phone to access CSU Bakersfield Police or dial (661) 654-2111 from all other phones.
- Notify your supervisor, faculty or staff member immediately.
- Be prepared to evacuate.
