- Purpose and Data Usage: Add a statement explaining the survey's purpose and how student data will be used.
- Revisions to Questions: Some revisions to the existing questions were proposed for improved clarity and relevance.
- Section V: It was recommended that Section V of the survey be eliminated.
- Survey Length and Attention Filters: The committee also suggested that IT consider reducing the survey length and incorporating attention filters to ensure high-quality responses.
